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COURSE PROJECT: Life Drawing-

This course is open to participants who have some drawing experience. Course projects give students an opportunity to deepen their understanding of drawing through regular study of a life model. We accept a maximum of 10 participants for our Life Drawing courses allowing the tutor time for individual attention. Participants will work from easels with a life model present for all sessions.

The course will help you to develop your observational skills and methods of measurement in figure drawing. Different drawing and watercolour techniques to describe the human form are considered. Participants will work from a selection of life models with a good balance of long and short poses. Working with colour experiments will encourage your own creative response to the figure. Areas to be covered include proportion and expressive mark-making leading on to Life Painting.

CORE SKILLS:

- Objective and traditional observation methods
- Learn how to structure the figure quickly and effectively
- Depicting tonal values and observing light and shades
- Handling watercolour, brushstrokes, line and wash
- Explore angles, shapes, gestures
- Learn to develop your own creative response and style

MATERIALS LIST:

A range of pencils: e.g. HB, B, 2B, 4B, 6B and a pencil sharpener, bulldog clips, box of mixed size willow charcoal sticks, putty rubber, preferably A2 (otherwise A3) cartridge and/or coloured paper, minimum of 2 coloured pencils, approx 2 sheets of A3 tracing paper.

Optional: Any other personally preferred materials e.g. graphite, pastels, paints, inks, pens, coloured pencils, conte crayons or pencils, black paper and white media etc. Paints won't be required for the first session. Materials will be discussed during your first session with your tutor and you may have already some art materials which can be used.
