Learn how to create two exposed spine books. During this workshop participants will learn how to fold and manipulate paper using specialist bookbinding tools and will learn two versatile bookbinding structures – the French link stitch and Link stitch bindings. These books do not require glue, and therefore lie completely flat when opened. They are ideal for presenting work, sketchbooks, gifts, or as the basis for artists' books. On completion of the workshop participants will leave with a set of their own books and the skills to make more at home using minimal equipment. The workshop is suitable for beginners. It is not suitable for under 15 years due to the sharp equipment being used.

Materials List:

All materials are included. Tools will be provided for the duration of the workshop.

You will be able to buy equipment on the day if you wish to. Please bring an apron.

Tutor:

The tutor will be a teacher from the London Centre for Book Arts.

Refreshments:

Tea and coffee are provided during the day. The workshop will allow for a one hour break at lunch time to be spent at your leisure. There is a seated area to eat lunch if you bring it with you, otherwise there are lots of cafes on the High Street nearby.
