The Landmark Summer Art School offers you the opportunity to discover your creative potential. Enjoy a moment of uninterrupted time to develop your art skills with individual tuition and guidance.

Our summer short courses are designed for small groups of adults beginners and returners who will benefit from furthering their own art projects.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is open to all abilities. Previous life drawing experience is not essential although beginners should ideally have done a little general drawing previously. Returners and those with experience will be encouraged and supported in deepening their own practice and in experimenting with new approaches.

The course combines traditional observational methods with exciting and innovative exercises designed to help you see and interpret the figure in new ways. A different life model will pose each day and there will be a good balance of long and short poses. You will be working from an easel either standing or sitting.

CORE SKILLS:

- Broad range of approaches to introduce different ways of observation.
- Explore proportion, plotting, angles, shapes and gestures.
- Learn how to structure your drawing.
- Depicting movement and expressive mark making.
- Drawing from standing, seated and reclining poses.
- Develop your own personal response to the figure.

MATERIALS LIST:

A range of pencils HB, B, 2B, 4B, 6B, sharpener, box of mixed size willow charcoal sticks, eraser, lots of A2 cartridge and/or coloured paper, minimum of 2 coloured pencils, approx 2 sheets of A3 tracing paper, masking tape, bulldog clips, 2 or 3 sheets of mid toned paper, black paper and white and dark conte or pastel pencil, scissors.

Optional: any other personally preferred materials, e.g. graphite, pastels, paints, inks, pens, coloured pencils, conte crayons, different types of paper.

All our Summer Art School courses will conclude with a review of the produced work on the final day. Complimentary tea/coffee/biscuits. The course allows for a daily lunch hour to be spent at your leisure.
