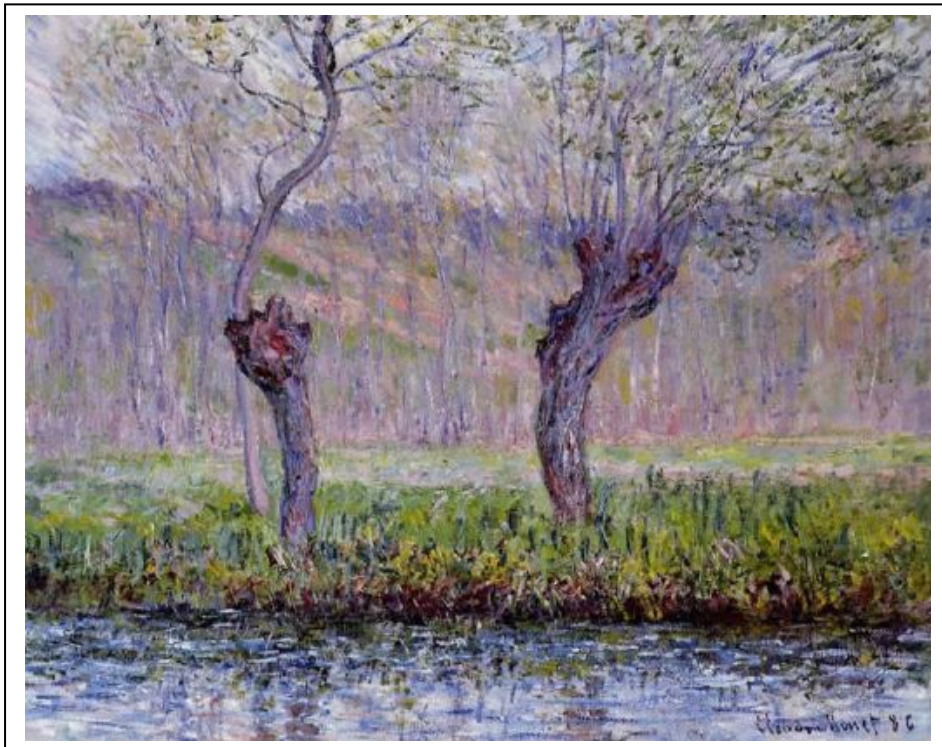

COURSE PROJECT: Landscape Sketching

Exploring the techniques of landscape sketching in its widest form; from pen and wash to other water based media. The course is structured to provide you with core skills and is designed for all levels of ability. There will be instruction on developing your sketches into a painting. We will be working both indoors and outside, weather permitting. Sketchbook work, composition and colour theory will be

discussed with a look at traditional styles as well as contemporary landscape painting by a range of artists.

CORE SKILLS:

1. Composing and designing from basic shapes to landscape and natural forms
2. Practice and applying drawing using a variety of techniques, with other materials and media
3. Experiment with various textures and surfaces to produce a range of different studies and styles both contemporary and traditional

MATERIALS LIST:

2 grades of pencil 2B – 6B

Soft kneadable rubber or sometimes called pastel rubber

Large soft watercolour brush size 12 and smaller brush size 6

Small set of pastels, charcoal and white conte

Black ink pen or biro

Pad of A3 paper and a small sketchbook
