

## **FACTSHEET: Tango Technique Guitar Workshop**

This special workshop is part of a one-day celebration of Tango. Taught by Argentinean Tango guitarist Javier Fioramonti, students will explore basic Tango rhythms, Milonga and Vals; approach to melody; common turnarounds and ornaments. Depending on students' level, chord melody, arrangements, finger picking and pick techniques will also be touched upon.

### **About the Tutor:**

Tango is a big part of Javier Fioramonti's musical life. He began with the music of Astor Piazzolla as a student at the National School of Music in Rosario, Argentina and then he moved on to the more traditional style of Argentine Tango playing. Based in London since 1991, he has been fortunate to work on a wide variety of projects with musicians from all over the world. He has performed with the top London Latin bands including Roberto Pla's Latin Jazz Ensemble and the Alex Wilson Salsa Orchestra. He also played for over 5 years with Scotland's Salsa Celtica touring extensively over the UK and Europe and recording two albums with the Band.
