Always wanted to try the traditional craft of template patchwork? This one-day course will introduce you to hand stitched patchwork using the traditional template technique, also known as English pieced paper. You will make a lovely six-pointed star, perfect for the top your Christmas or as a gift.

You will master covering templates accurately and then hand stitching them together so that they form a star. Embellishments can be added including buttons, beads and a handy hanging ribbon. A pleasing project that can be completed in a day and once you have learnt this technique you could easily tackle something a little larger like a cushion, table runner or even a small quilt

## **MATERIALS LIST:**

All materials will be provided, however if there are personal festive decorations or fabrics that you would like to use for your star please bring those along.

## **TUTOR:**

Christine is an inspiring tutor with a wealth of teaching and design experience and a holistic approach to creativity. Her unique creative profile includes 12 years as a graphic designer at the BBC and being Head of Film and Animation at Kingston University, author of 'Contemporary Needlepoint' and Kodak's Young Photographer of the year (some time ago!). She has also won a clutch of international awards and been nominated for a BAFTA. Her textiles have been shown at the Contemporary Textiles Gallery in London and her graphic work has been published in various journals and books. As a freelancer, she has made 80 velvet scarves for 'Mary Poppins' on Broadway NY and even filmed a funeral for the Queen. She is passionate about lettering and paper cutting and enjoys sharing her enthusiasm with her students.

## **REFRESHMENTS:**

Tea and coffee are provided during the day and the workshop will also allow for a one hour break at lunch time to be spent at your leisure.
