COURSE PROJECT: Exploring Landscape Painting

Explore Landscape sketching and painting techniques including both studio studies and outdoor work. Designed for all levels, core skills will be covered on how to develop preliminary sketches into paintings. Materials excluded.

LESSON 1 – Get to know your materials – Line Tone and Texture
Using a range of drawing materials

LESSON 2 – Fast and Loose - Making quick gestural drawings using pencil, pen or pastel

LESSON 3 – River, streams, reflections.

LESSON 4 – Trees, foliage, brushwork.

LESSON 5 - Picture Making - Working up a sketch with a view to painting.

CORE SKILLS:

1. Composing and designing from basic shapes to landscape and natural forms
2. Practice and applying drawing using a variety of techniques, with other materials and media
3. Experiment with various textures and surfaces to produce a range of different studies and styles both contemporary and traditional

Covid-19 Safety Measures:
