This is a dynamic photography course, which looks at lighting and exposures over a range of conditions. It explores spontaneous and street photography, capturing life on the move and helping participants master the art of freezing and blurring motion and photographing action and movement effectively, whatever the situation.

The course looks at new and different forms of composition and builds up to a project where participants create their own photographic story. The art of visual story telling provides a narrative structure and clear purpose for capturing any activity or event. This is a highly interactive course, which gives participants the confidence to photograph subjects that inspire and capture their imagination. Suitable for beginners and more experienced photographers looking to refresh their skills.
